જીવનની સાચી જરૂરિયાત

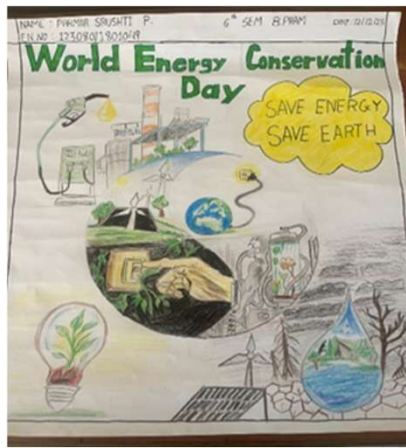

થોડા સમય પહેલા બનેલી કફ સિરખની ઘટના યાદ કરીએ, જ્યાં ખોટી રીતે બનેલી દવાને કારણે નાના બાળકોના જીવ ગયા. તે માતા પિતાની પીડા ને વિચારીએ તો હૃદય કંપિ ઊઠે. દવા જે આરોગ્ય આપવા માટે હતી, આજે દુઃખનું કારણ બની કારણ કે ક્યાંક માનવતા અને ધર્મ વ્યવહારમાં ઉતર્યા ન હતા. દુનિયાના અન્ય ખૂણે ડ્રગ માફિયા ની ઘટનાઓ પણ બતાવે છે કે જ્યારે લાલચ માનવતા પર હાવી થઈ જાય, ક્યારે દવા સેવા નહીં પરંતુ વિનાશનું સાધન બની જાય છે. આ બધું ક્યારે બને છે જ્યારે માણસ પોતાના અંતર આત્માને ભૂલી જાય છે.

આથી સમજાય છે કે જીવનની સાચી જરૂરિયાત માત્ર દેહનું પોષણ નથી, પરંતુ આત્માને શુદ્ધિ છે. જો ધર્મ આપણા વર્તનમાં ઉતરે, જો કામમાં ઈમાનદારી અને કડુણા જોડાય, અને જો માણસ પહેલા "માણસ" બને તો જ જીવનનું પરિણામ સકારાત્મક બને. નહિતર બહાર સફળતા હોવા છતાં અંદર ખાલીપો જ રહે છે. ચીજ, વસ્તુ, પદાર્થ જેવી ભૌતિક વસ્તુઓનું મૂલ્ય આત્માના કલ્યાણ આગળ શૂન્ય બરાબર છે.

જીવનની સાચી જરૂરિયાત આત્મિક ઉન્નતિ, સંયમિત ઇન્દ્રિયો અને પરમાત્મા સાથેનું જીવંત જોડાણ છે. જ્યારે માણસ પોતાના કાર્યને સેવા અને સાધના સમજીને જીવે છે, દરેક કાર્ય પ્રભુના ભજન કરતા-કરતા કરે છે, ત્યારે જીવન સંતુલિત બને છે અને આ જ જીવનને પવિત્ર અને સફળ બનાવે છે.

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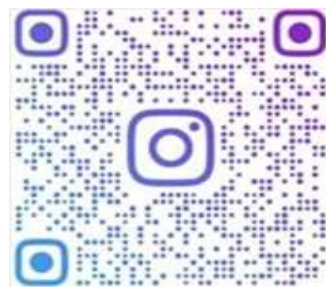
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
